### Access Keys

This site includes "Access Keys" to assist users with disabilities navigate their way through the site. Access keys are keyboard shortcuts that allow users to navigate to common pages without the use of a mouse. How to use access keys

Below you will find instructions on how to use Access Keys based on the browser you use.&bull;Internet Explorer 5+: Hold down the ALT key and select the number/letter of the access key, then press ENTER.&bull;Internet Explorer 4: Hold down the ALT key and select the number/letter of the access key.&bull;Internet Explorer 5+ for Mac: Hold down the CTRL key and select the number/letter of the access key.&bull;Internet Explorer 4.5 for Mac: Access keys are not supported.&bull;Netscape 6+: Hold down the ALT key and select the number/letter of the access key.&bull;Netscape earlier versions: Access keys are not supported.&bull;Mozilla: Hold down the ALT key and select the number/letter of the access key.
